## ACCOMMODATION

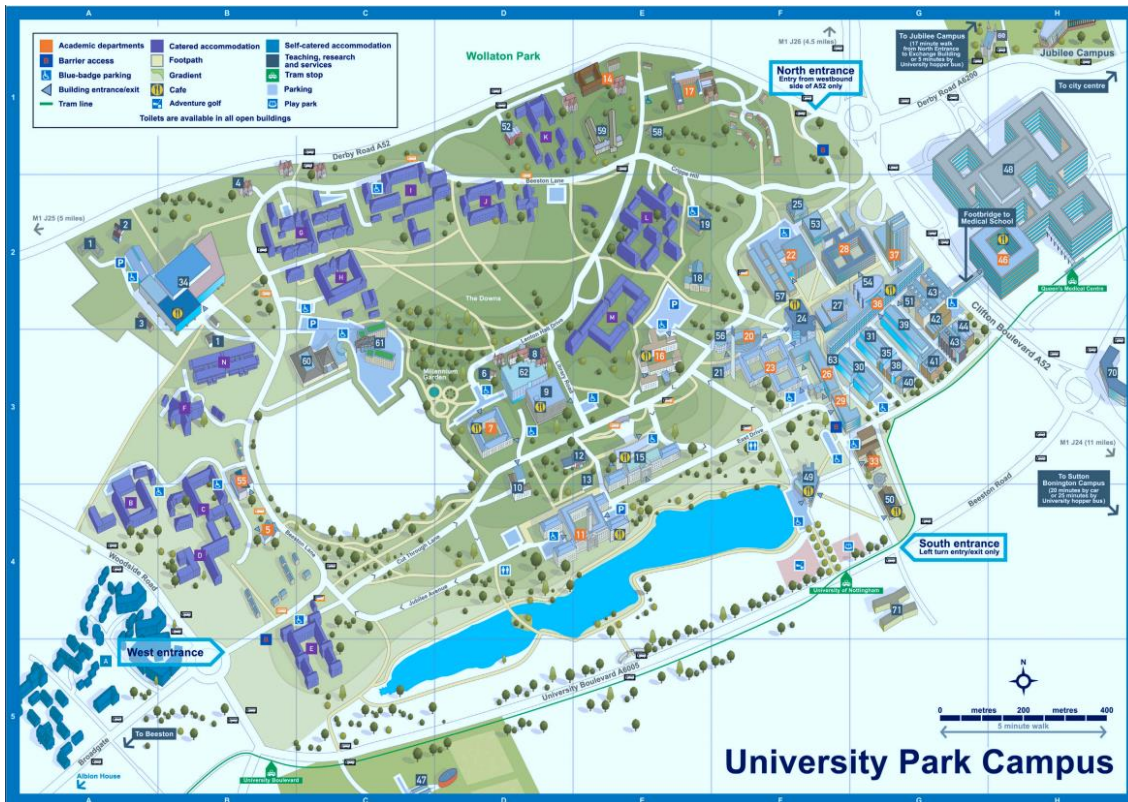
